Class size is limited to **20 scouts maximum per badge** and will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis. Scouts should list their badge preferences according to 1st choice, 2nd choice and 3rd choice. All registration **must be received at the AGC office by Friday, October 8, 2010 to guarantee a roster spot for your scouts, and t-shirts.** Scouts will have to acquire the appropriate merit badge book and study it prior to attending the class. There may be some requirements for the merit badges that must be completed before or after the November 6th event. It will be the responsibility of each troop leader to verify that any badge requirement that is to be done before or after November 6 is actually completed in a satisfactory manner.

There is no cost to the scouts for this event. Scouts will be provided lunch for the day. It is preferred that the scouts remain on campus during lunch. To assist with the event, we require that two leaders from each scout troop be present the entire day. We encourage the scouts to be in uniform for this event, and act accordingly. Anyone disrupting a class will be removed and prohibited from further participation in this event. It is our hope that many scouts will be able to participate and enjoy this day.

A new policy for the event requires any troops who register for the event and do not attend without giving adequate notice (minimum 1 week before the event) will not be able to attend the following year.

The opening and closing ceremony and classes will be held in the Department of Industrial and Engineering Technology at Murray State University (Martha Collins Center). The schedule is:
