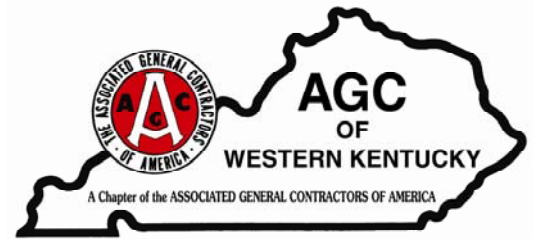

Class size is limited to **10 scouts maximum per topic** and will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis. Girl Scouts should list their topic preferences according to 1<sup>st</sup> choice, 2<sup>nd</sup> choice and 3<sup>rd</sup> choice. All registration **must be received at the AGC by Friday, January 29, 2010.**

There is no cost to the Girl Scouts for this event. Girl Scouts and troop leaders will be provided lunch for the day. It is preferred that the Girl Scouts remain on campus during lunch. To assist with the event, we require that two leaders from each troop be present the entire day. We encourage the Girl Scouts to be in uniform for this event, and act accordingly. Anyone disrupting a class will be removed and prohibited from further participation in this event. It is our hope that many Girl Scouts will be able to participate and enjoy this day.
